Commissioned in 1979 as a Second Lieutenant, he has participated in numerous overseas operations such as Operation Restore Hope in Somalia, and Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn in Iraq.

He has completed three tours of duty in Iraq in addition to combat service in Somalia, parachuted with Paratroopers and Rangers more than 200 times and served as the lead conduit with the Iraqi government from 2008-2010.

In his last role with the US Army as Commanding General, LTG Ferriter led 75 Army installations and bases, comprised of a 75,000-person workforce, while managing a \$12 billion budget. Through his strategic leadership, he successfully cut costs and achieved savings of nearly \$3 billion by transforming the way business was conducted and services delivered.
